Q: How does quality vary among Cat Rubber Track options?

A: All Cat Rubber Track is constructed of quality materials and manufactured with consistent processes to ensure reliability and compatibility with other Cat Rubber Track components. General Duty and Premium Rubber Tracks do not have the same life expectancy because each is intended to work within different cost parameters and applications.

Q: How does performance vary among Cat Rubber Track options?

A: Like many other product lines, our Rubber Track portfolio has options to meet different customer requirements. Tread style to tread style, the performance expectations of the General Duty Track are similar to Premium Track, with lower life expectancy. The difference in life expectancy will be larger when operating in aggressive and/or harsh applications and smaller in light applications with soft underfoot conditions.

Q: Is General Duty Rubber Track a genuine Cat Rubber Track?

A: Yes. General Duty and Premium Rubber Tracks are validated by Caterpillar engineers to meet the established goals of product performance and manufactured with consistent processes to ensure quality is aligned with product expectations required to carry the Cat brand.

Q: Why was General Duty Rubber Track added to the Cat Rubber Track portfolio?

A: Caterpillar added General Duty Rubber Track based on global dealer and customer research. General Duty offers another option to help customers optimize value when the full value of Cat Premium Rubber Track is not needed.
